Abstract:

We present a case of progressive enlarging hepatic cyst causing obstructive jaundice complicated with cholangitis that was successfully managed with ethanol sclerotherapy.

A 82-year-old male patient was admitted to ER with the chief complaint of fever and chillness. He was initially managed as acute cholangitis and arranged with endoscopic retrograde cholangiopancreatography. Progressive jaundice after the intervention made his previously known hepatic cyst as a more likely cause. Pigtail drainage of hepatic cyst was made. And further ethanol sclerotherapy was undertaken. His bilirubin level returned back to normal level on discharge. The hepatic cyst showed progressive regression in follow up.

Hepatic cyst compression should always be taken into consideration when it coexists with CBD cholangitis in patient with obstructive jaundice. Ethanol sclerotherapy may be an effective way of treatment.
