英文題目：Traumatic Delayed Rupture of the Gallbladder

**Background and Aims:** Injury to the gallbladder from blunt abdominal trauma is uncommon. We report a case of delayed rupture of the gallbladder following blunt trauma to the abdomen.

**Methods:** A 79-year-old man was referred to our hospital because of the finding of large-volume ascites via abdominal ultrasound. The nuclear medicine scan demonstrated spread of the “leaked” tracer from the gallbladder to the peritoneal cavity.

**Results:** Traumatic delayed rupture of gallbladder was diagnosed.

**Conclusions:** Delayed rupture of gallbladder derived from contusion is difficult to diagnose. Percutaneous drainage alone may obviate the need for cholecystectomy.
