TITLE (in capital letters)

Authors (Initial Surname, etc.)

Institution

Category (CC or CL)

The scientific content will be divided into the following items with a maximum of **3000 characters (including spaces)**.

The content of the summary must conform to the following parameters:

**For free communications FC**

<b>Title</b>	It must be related to the content.
<b>Introduction</b>	Brief and that introduces the subject of the investigation
<b>Objectives</b>	They must be concise, explicit, start with a verb
<b>Material methods and</b>	<p>Describe the type of design</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Prospective or retrospective or mixed.</li> <li>➤ Longitudinal or transverse.</li> <li>➤ Observational or experimental.</li> <li>➤ Descriptive or analytical.</li> </ul> <p>Describe Population based on inclusion criteria, exclusion criteria, elimination criteria, time and place.</p> <p>Sampling type.</p> <p>Statistics used.</p> <p>Brief description of how the study was conducted.</p>
<b>Results</b>	<p><u>Sample epidemiology</u>:sex, age, days of stay, etc.</p> <p><u>Descriptive statistics</u>: percentages must go with IC95. The means must be accompanied by other measurements (DS, ES, IC95), as well as the median (MAD, quartiles).</p> <p><u>Inferential statistics and regression</u>: the comparisons must have the p value and/or the OR/RR with their CI 95.</p>
<b>Conclusions</b>	Concrete. They must respond to the objectives and be supported by the results.
<b>Keywords</b>	Up to 5 descriptors.

**For clinical case CC**

<b>Title</b>	It must be related to the content.
<b>Introduction</b>	Brief comment that guides the generality of the topic. ALWAYS clarify that the anonymity of the case is maintained.
<b>Case</b>	<p><u>It includes:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Sex.</li> <li>➤ Age.</li> <li>➤ Reason for consultation.</li> <li>➤ Relevant background.</li> <li>➤ Data relevant to physical examination.</li> <li>➤ Data relevant to helper methods.</li> <li>➤ therapy used.</li> <li>➤ Evolution, highlighting the identified Clinical Problems.</li> </ul>
<b>Comment</b>	<p>Clinical discussion in relation to <u>Importance/ justification</u> of the presentation of the same, either by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Infrequency.</li> <li>➤ Worth <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ etiological</li> <li>○ Forecast</li> <li>○ Diagnosis</li> <li>○ Therapeutic.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>Importance of differential diagnosis.</p> <p>Teaching importance.</p>
<b>Conclusions</b>	If appropriate.
<b>Keywords</b>	Up to 5 descriptors.

## Submission of the full manuscript for an award

- Cover (title, authors, institution) and summary with keywords.
- Sections for CL: introduction, material and methods, results, discussion, conclusions, bibliography.
- CC sections: introduction, case description, discussion, conclusions, bibliography.
- Written in TNR 12 font.
- Spacing 1.5.
- Margins 2 cm. (top, bottom, left, right).
- Maximum 30 total pages.
- All the work in 1 single file that must have a weight of less than 25 Mb.
- Bibliography: between ( ) and in order of appearance in the text, with the following format:

Magazine	Valdez P, Milione H, Cámara L et al (if there are 4, put all 4, if there are more than 4, put et al). Article name. year magazine; volume: initial-final page. REMEMBER: if there is volume and page DOES NOT HAVE DOI OR WEB ADDRESS
Book	Authors of the chapter (same as magazine). Chapter title. In: authors of the book. Name of the book. Publisher year. Pp: initial-final page.
Internet	Authors (if any) or institution. Name of the publication. Year (if any). Web address or DOI. Consulted in (month year)
